30 Hours Extended Entitlement to Funded Early Education and Childcare for eligible 3 and 4 year olds



If you are eligible you can claim up to 1140 hours of nationally funded early education and childcare for your 3-4 year old stretched over the year, or for 30 hours each week in term-time.

You can take these funded hours

in pre-schools, with day nurseries, childminders and schools where the offer is available. You may also be able to purchase additional hours and services. Please discuss your needs with your child's early years provider or school. To be eligible:

- Both parents must be working (or the sole parent if in a lone parent family)
- Each parent must have a weekly minimum income equivalent to 16 hours at national minimum wage or national living wage
- Each parent must have an income less than £100,000 per year.

To apply you need to register on the childcare choices website: www.childcarechoices.gov.uk and claim your voucher code before the end of each term to be eligible for the following term. This code must then be taken to your early years provider or school to arrange your place.

To claim your extended entitlement for the Autumn Term 2017 you must apply and have received your eligibility code before the 31st August 2017.

For the Spring Term 2018, you must apply and have received your eligibility code before the 31st December 2017

For the Summer Term 2018, you must apply and have received your eligibility code before 31st March 2018.
