If you live in the City of York Council area, applications should be made online at https://www.york.gov.uk/admissions and if you live in the North Yorkshire County Council area, the website is at https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/school-admissions

The closing date is 15 January 2022. Even if your child already attends our Nursery, you still need to make an application for a Reception school place.
