A message from Mrs Holmes

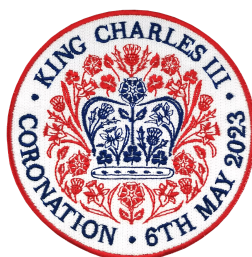

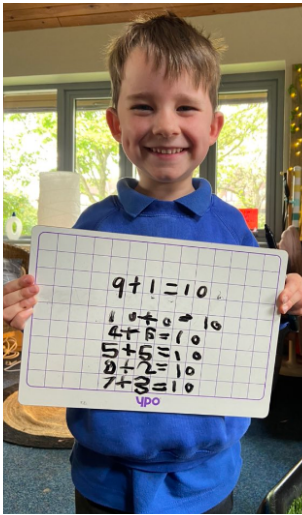
Our Year 6 children have blown us away with their attitude and efforts throughout their SATs this week. They all enjoyed a well deserved Dominoes lunch to celebrate!
