*Well done to our Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 Cricket teams in their recent cricket tournaments. All children represented the school brilliantly.*





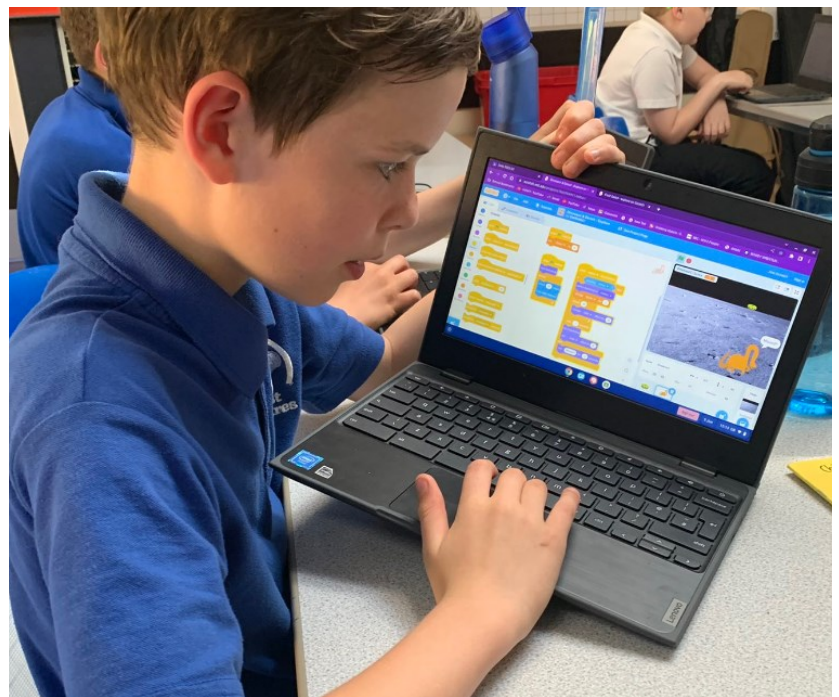
In Design Technology, Hedgehogs have been learning about wheels, axles and axle holders.

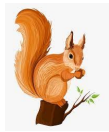
