

Our Road Safety Curriculum

Early Years	 Understand the difference between the footpath and the road. Know to walk with a grown up and hold hands when near a road Introduce Stop, Look, Listen and Think.
KS1	 Understand that pedestrians walk on the pavement and vehicles travel on the road. Understand the Stop, Look, Listen and Think sequence. Know to travel in a car wearing a seatbelt. Understand how walking and cycling can keep them healthy.
Lower Key stage 2	 Introduce the Green Cross Code including recognising safe crossing places on the road side. Introduce road signs and pedestrian crossings. Understand they may feel at risk as a passenger and it is ok to speak out. Understand their responsibilities as a passenger in a car to wear a seatbelt and behave sensibly. Introduce the Highway Code.
Upper Key stage 2	 Know the Green Cross Code including recognising safe crossing places on the road side. Have an understanding of road signs and pedestrian crossings. To be able to identify when they feel at risk as a passenger and develop a strategy to speak out (passenger power). Understand their responsibilities as a passenger in a car to wear a seatbelt and behave sensibly. Have an increased awareness of the Highway Code. Ride a bike and have participated in some Cycle Training. Be able to plan a safe journey to secondary school.
