

Our Road Safety Curriculum

Early Years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Understand the difference between the footpath and the road. ● Know to walk with a grown up and hold hands when near a road ● Introduce Stop, Look, Listen and Think.
KS1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Understand that pedestrians walk on the pavement and vehicles travel on the road. ● Understand the Stop, Look, Listen and Think sequence. ● Know to travel in a car wearing a seatbelt. ● Understand how walking and cycling can keep them healthy.
Lower Key stage 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Introduce the Green Cross Code including recognising safe crossing places on the road side. ● Introduce road signs and pedestrian crossings. ● Understand they may feel at risk as a passenger and it is ok to speak out. ● Understand their responsibilities as a passenger in a car to wear a seatbelt and behave sensibly. ● Introduce the Highway Code.
Upper Key stage 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Know the Green Cross Code including recognising safe crossing places on the road side. ● Have an understanding of road signs and pedestrian crossings. ● To be able to identify when they feel at risk as a passenger and develop a strategy to speak out (passenger power). ● Understand their responsibilities as a passenger in a car to wear a seatbelt and behave sensibly. ● Have an increased awareness of the Highway Code. ● Ride a bike and have participated in some Cycle Training. ● Be able to plan a safe journey to secondary school.
