Acorns used tools to carefully sculpt their clay models which they had designed the previous week. They took their time, looked back at what they had drawn and were so happy with their finished products!



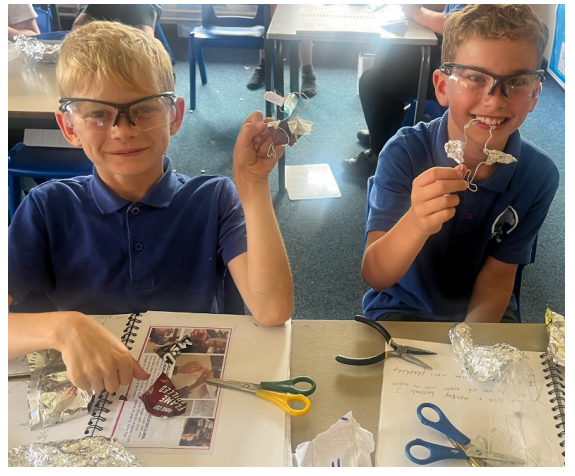
Every class has visited Easingwold Library over the past two weeks. We travelled there by local bus, joined the library, got our own library cards and shared stories.
