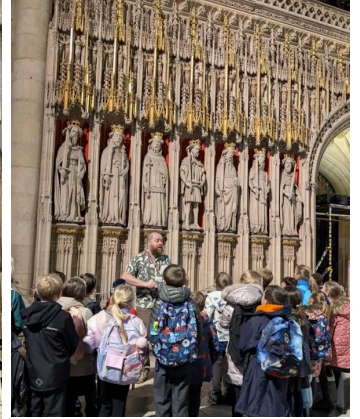
On their local area walk, Conkers and Acorns looked at road signs, the postbox, the importance of a bus timetable and explored the local park! #FOGGeography
