This is the recommended minimum expectation for children following the Read Write Inc Phonics Programme; including speed sound, Storybook and Get writing. Children are assessed every half term and placed in homogenous groups based on their current level of learning. They are taught in daily sessions by a member of staff trained in RWI.

Fast Track tutoring, afternoon phonics sessions and Talk through Stories are used alongside to ensure children 'keep up' with the recommended progress. Children will take the Phonics

Screening Check (PSC) in Year 1 and a Phonics screening assessment will be done 3 times a year to check children's progress towards this. Any children that do not pass the PSC in Year 1 will retake the test in Year 2.
